Arjowiggins Creative Papers produces fine and speciality papers for distribution around the world. The company is certified ISO14001 & FSC-STD-40-004 v2.1 chain of custody standard. This enables our products to be sold as certified products under customer requirements. In support of this, it is our policy to purchase, fibres from FSC controlled non-controversial wood sources. This excludes wood harvested illegally, from forest areas, where traditional or civil rights are violated, have high conservation values which are threatened, natural forest that has been converted to plantations or non-forest use, and genetically modified trees.
